

Daily Appearance

CCS believes that Christian discipline also applies to our physical appearance. The way the student appears in his/her uniform is important, and it should not be a factor that takes away from their Christian education. Therefore, the CCS Board has adopted the following guidelines for wearing uniforms:

1. The uniform must be in good condition and clean.
2. Only the uniform items as mentioned in the uniform list may be worn. Substitutions of the Lands' End brand must have an exact, or nearly exact, appearance. All uniforms that do not conform to this rule will not be allowed at any grade level.
3. The student must wear his/her uniform pants with the waistband fitting snugly around the waist. Uniform pants, shorts, skirts or skorts may not be worn sagging down to the top of, or the middle of, the hips. Uniform skirts and skorts may not be shorter than 2 inches above the knee. If shorts are not ordered through Land's End, they may not be shorter than 2 inches above the knee.
4. The boys must wear their shirt tucked into their pants at all times.
5. The student must wear a plain black or brown belt with pants.
6. The student must wear shoes at all times. Flip-flops, slippers, ballet slippers, sandals without heel straps, work boots, and bare feet are not permitted. All shoes and sandals must be worn with socks.
7. Athletic shoes and socks are required for all PE activities.
8. Any shirt showing at the neckline under the uniform must be one of the colors of the polo shirts (example: white polo shirt with a navy undershirt). Those shirts worn under the uniform shirt may not show from the waistline area of your shirt.

Friday School Spirit Wear

The CCS Board has adopted the following for wear on Fridays:

1. The student may wear his/her uniform.
2. The student may wear blue jeans, uniform pants, or girls may wear denim skirts (not shorter than 2 inches above the knee), that shall be worn with the waist band fitting snugly around the waist, without allowing them to sag down to the hips, and,
3. The student may wear, with the blue jeans or denim skirt, either a uniform shirt, a school T-shirt (available through the school office), or a Christian T-shirt.

Cooler Weather Wear

While outdoors students are permitted to wear a coat of their choosing.

Indoors, students may only wear authorized uniforms, spirit wear, uniform sweaters, and school sweatshirts: plain navy blue or with the school logo on it.

CCS Uniform Code

Boys – K through 5th

- Pants – pleated or plain - Chinos, Corduroy or Cargo Chino (cargo pants must be identical to those in the Lands' End catalog) - navy only
- Shorts – pleated or plain Chino or Lands' End style Cargo shorts - navy only (Beginning of year until 10/15 and after Easter break to end of year)
- Polo-style shirt – short or long sleeve – evergreen, navy or white
- Turtleneck shirt – white only / worn under sweaters (pullover or cardigan)
- Crewneck pullover sweater, cardigan sweater (zip-up style ok) and sweater vests - navy only
- Sweatshirt pullover or zip-up (hooded ok) and Polartec jacket - navy only
- Appropriate belt (plain black or brown)
- Shoes must complement the uniform and must be safe for recess and PE activities.

Girls – K through 5th

- Jumper – Lands' End Hunter/Classic Navy Plaid (H/CNP) and navy only (not shorter than 2" above the knee)
- Skirts – Lands' End plaid (H/C NP) and navy only – A-line or pleated styles only (not shorter than 2 inches above the knee)
- Skort – At-the-knee Lands' End Chino Skort only (not shorter than 2 inches above the knee) navy only
- Crop Chinos (Capri's) navy only (Beginning of the year until 10/15 and after Easter break until end of year)
- Chino or Cargo Shorts – pleated or plain front Lands' End style - navy only (Beginning of the year until 10/15 and after Easter break until end of year) Shorts may not be shorter than 2 inches above the knee.
- Pants – pleated or plain (no low-rise pants) navy only
- Blouse – short or long sleeve plain white with peter-pan collar, woven or knit (both Dainty ruffle & She-shaped style)

- Polo-style shirt – (fit-for-her) short or long sleeve / mesh or interlock – evergreen, navy or white
- Turtleneck shirt – white only / worn under jumpers or sweaters (pullover or cardigan)
- Cable crewneck pullover sweater, fine gage cardigan sweater, cable hoodie sweater and sweater vest - navy only
- Sweatshirt pullover or zip-up (hooded ok) Polartec jacket - navy only
- Shoes must complement the uniform and must be safe for recess and PE activities. No heels or platform shoes. (See Daily Appearance section for sandal requirements).
- Leggings or bike shorts must be worn under jumpers and skirts. Leggings must be navy (no designs); bike shorts can be navy or black and must not be longer than the jumper or skirt.

**If parents choose to purchase items elsewhere, they must be identical in style and color. We expect all students to come to school in uniforms that are clean and in good repair.

BOYS – 6th-8th

- Pants – pleated or plain - Chinos, Corduroy or Cargo chino (cargo pants must be identical to those in the Lands’ End catalog) navy or khaki only
- Shorts – pleated or plain Chino or Lands’ End style Cargo shorts - navy or khaki only (Beginning of year until 10/15 and after Easter break until end of year)
- Polo-style shirt – short or long sleeve - evergreen, navy or white
- Turtleneck shirt – white only / worn under sweaters (pullover or cardigan)
- Crewneck pullover sweater, cardigan sweater (zip-up style ok) and sweater vests- navy or white only
- Sweatshirt pullover or zip-up (hooded ok) - plain navy or white only Polartec – navy
- Appropriate belt (plain black or brown)
- Shoes must complement the uniform and be safe for the days activities.

GIRLS – 6th- 8th

- Skirts – Lands’ End plaid (H/CNP), navy or khaki - A-line or Pleated styles only (not shorter than 2 inches above the knee)
- Skort – At-the-knee Lands’ End Chino Skort only (not shorter than 2 inches above the knee) navy or khaki,
- Crop Chinos (Capri’s) navy or khaki (Beginning of the year until 10/15 and after Easter break until end of year)
- Chino or Cargo Shorts – pleated or plain front Lands’ End style - navy or khaki (Beginning of the year until 10/15 and after Easter break until end of year) Shorts may not be shorter than 2 inches above the knee.
- Pants – pleated or plain (no low-rise pants) navy or khaki
- Blouse – short or long sleeve plain white with peter-pan collar, woven or knit (both Dainty ruffle & She-shaped style)

- Polo-style shirt – (fit-for-her) short or long sleeve / mesh or interlock - evergreen, navy or white
- Turtleneck shirt – white or navy / worn under sweaters (pullover or cardigan)
- Cable crewneck pullover sweater, fine gage cardigan sweater, cable hoodie sweater and sweater vest-navy or white only
- Sweatshirts pullover or zip-up (hooded ok) plain navy or white only. Polartec – navy
- Shoes must complement the uniform and must be safe for the day’s activities. (See Daily Appearance section for sandal requirements)
- Leggings or bike shorts must be worn under skirts. Leggings must be navy; bike shorts can be navy or black and must not be longer than the skirt.

**If parents choose to purchase items elsewhere, they must be identical in style and color. We expect all students to come to school in uniforms that are clean and in good repair.

Free Dress Days

On announced days, and on certain outdoor field trips, students are allowed free dress with the following rules: Students are expected to be clean, neat and dressed modestly. Their clothing is to be in good taste and worn properly at all times. The following items may not be worn: anything spandex, skirts shorter than 2 inches above the knee, skirts with slits that extend more than 2 inches above the knee, off the shoulder and/or low-cut blouses, tops with spaghetti straps, tank tops with straps under 2” wide, mid-drifts (shirts must come below the waist line of pants, skirts, skorts, etc.), flip-flops, slippers, combat and/or fatigue clothes, athletic and/or workout sweats. T-shirts, sweaters or jackets with questionable logos will not be allowed. Hats may be worn outside only.

Field Trip Wear

On field trips students are allowed free dress, as stated above, at the teacher’s discretion.

Jewelry

A limited amount of modest jewelry is allowed. Boys may not wear earrings. No facial or body piercing jewelry is allowed at school. Watches and MEDIC ALERT IDs are allowed for both boys and girls.

Tattoos

Students are not permitted to display tattoos whether permanent or temporary.

Make-up and Hair

6th-8th Grade girls are permitted to wear make-up in a modest and appropriate manner.

6th-8th Grade students may color their hair in a natural color (ex. pink, blue, electric orange, et.al, are not natural). This color must be maintained during the school year. It may only be changed over Christmas or Spring break. Violation of this rule will result in a 1-3 day in-school suspension.

6th-8th Grade boys are not permitted to grow facial hair. Their hair length must not be below the collar, over the eyes, or completely cover the ears.

It is expected that parents will enforce all aspects of the dress regulation as outlined above. If necessary, teachers and administrators will counsel those who do not adhere to the school's standards. If your child is dressed inappropriately, you will be required to bring the proper attire to school so that he/she can change. Repeated offenses may result in discipline and/or fines. Your cooperation in this area is essential and much appreciated.
